My work for the exhibition “Drawnonward” evolved quite dramatically over the last six months. I began with a series of ceramic boat forms – firstly as a very black comment on the ‘boat people’ and their horrific plight – and from there to happier associations with boats. From these I returned to printmaking, in particular monoprints and monotypes, concentrating on surface texture and colour.
