Jason began painting in the year 2000, and gains his inspiration from artists such as Clifford Possum Tjapaltjarri. Jason has also had the pleasure of exhibiting with Clifford Possum's daughter Sally.

Jason enjoys creating bark paintings and acrylic works on canvas. However he is not interested in painting landscapes as his work centres around traditional themes and imagery.

Throughout his artistic career Jason has held 4 solo exhibitions in cities ranging from Canberra, Brisbane, Adelaide and Portland. And has work in private collections all over the world.
